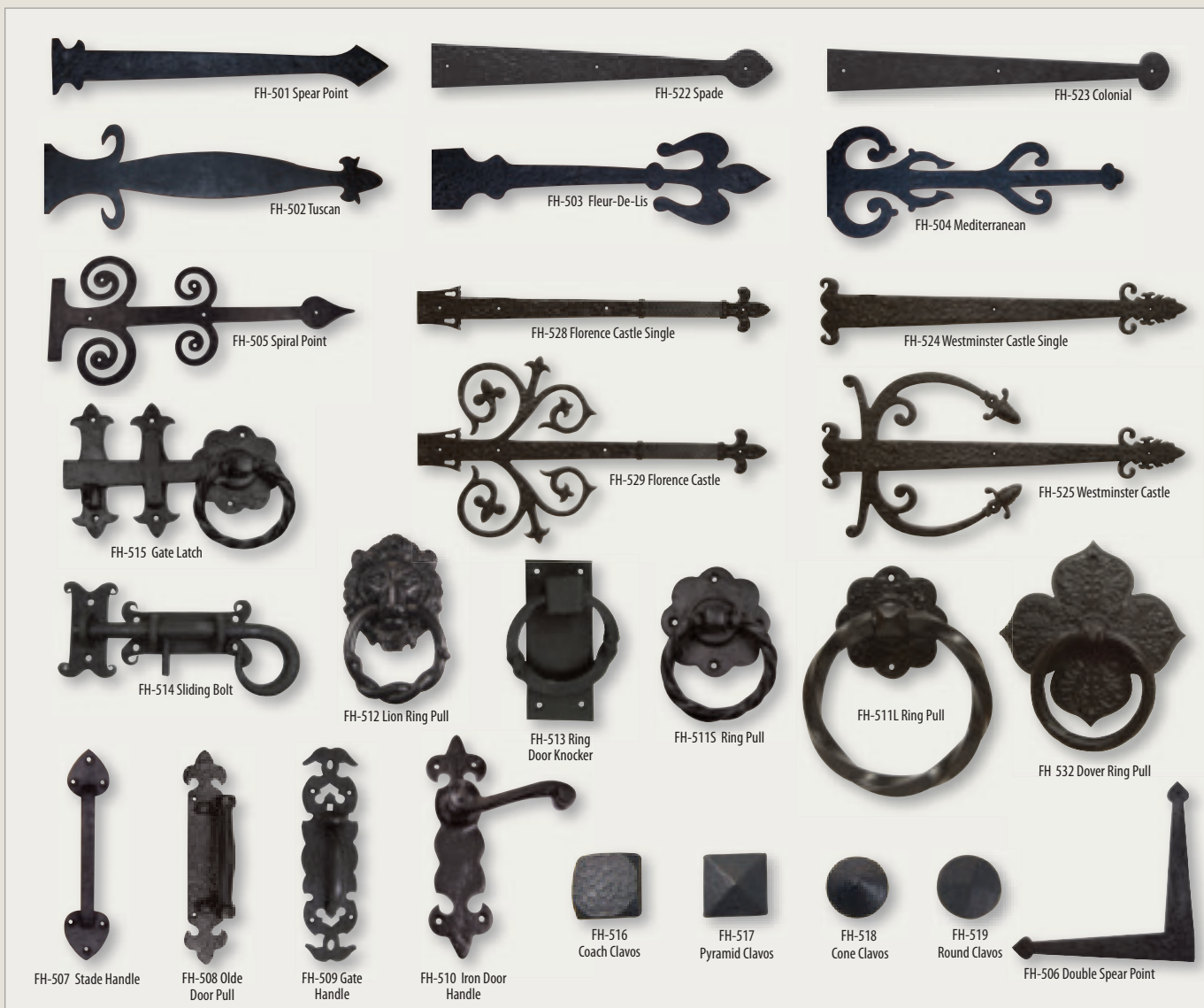
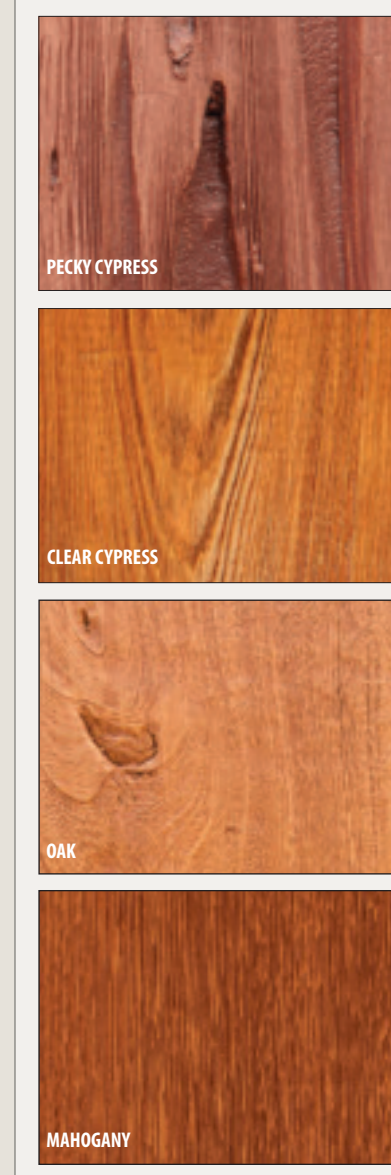


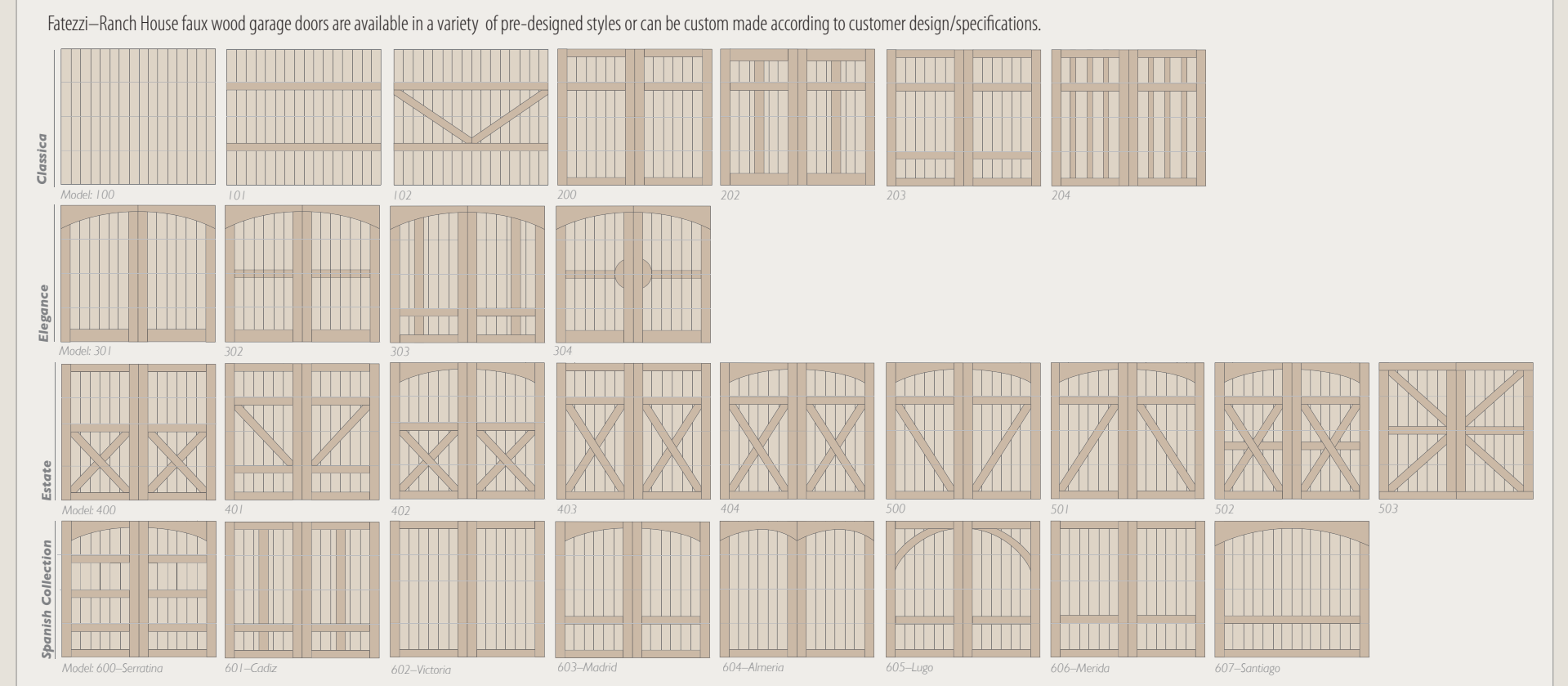

Using plain vanilla garage doors can make an otherwise beautiful house boring. Wooden garage doors will dramatically enhance a home's curb appeal and value. Fatezzi™-Ranch House® faux wood garage doors bring together the best of natural wood's beauty and proven polymer composite engineering. The faux wood claddings are molded from real wood to replicate the intricate texture of natural wood. Unlike other composite materials that are heavy and manufactured with unrealistic replication of wood grains, the Fatezzi-Ranch House 1/2 inch high definition faux wood truly replicates everything including imperfections of natural wood like deep irregular pockmarks, knots, cracks, and holes up to 1/4 inch deep. Once installed, they are virtually indistinguishable from real wood.

Fatezzi-Ranch House faux wood does not have the drawbacks inherent with natural wood. It is lightweight, yet very strong, more durable and easier to maintain than real wood. It is UV resistant and virtually impervious to moisture and will not rot, split, or crack even in high humidity, desert heat and freezing weather conditions.

Fatezzi-Ranch House claddings are installed using proprietary adhesives without mechanical fasteners. As a result, the claddings will not delaminate or introduce corrosion over time. All Fatezzi-Ranch House garage doors come with a three-year limited product warranty.

Our faux wood claddings are available in a variety of wood species like Pecky Cypress, Clear Cypress, Oak, Mahogany and Ash. Door claddings can be painted or stained to create any desired finish. Fatezzi-Ranch House garage doors are available in a variety of pre-designed styles or can be custom made according to customer specifications. Optional decorative hardware straps, clavos, door handles and pulls are available to enhance the character of the doors.
